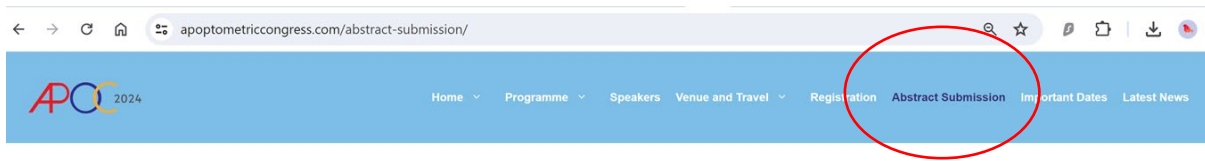
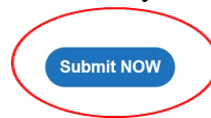

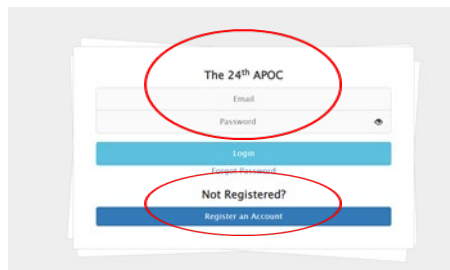
Go to the APOC 2024 website and click on the “abstract Submission” heading.



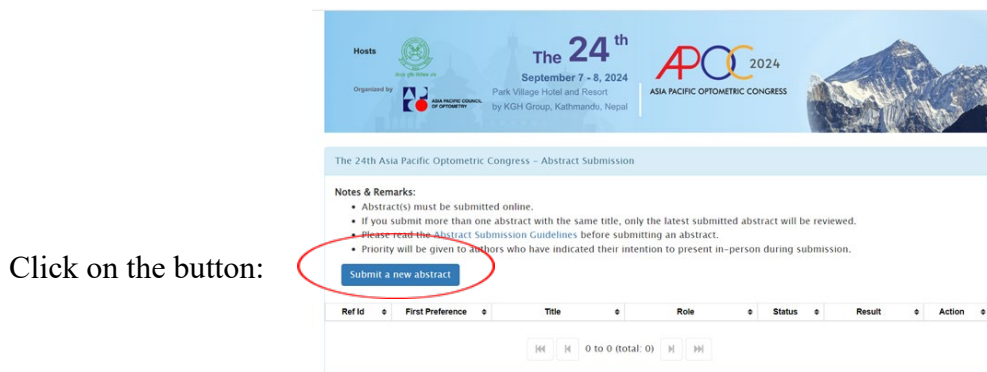
In the abstract submission page, read the guidelines, when ready to submit, scroll to the bottom and click the button to submit



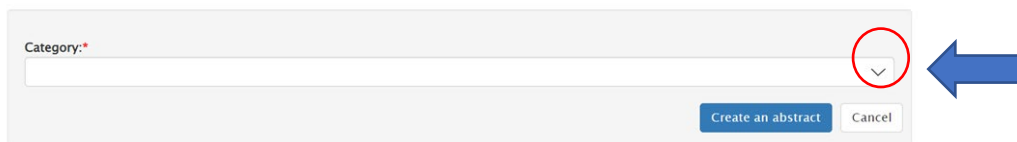
You will then reach a page to ask you to register an account, you will need an email address and a password to set up an account.



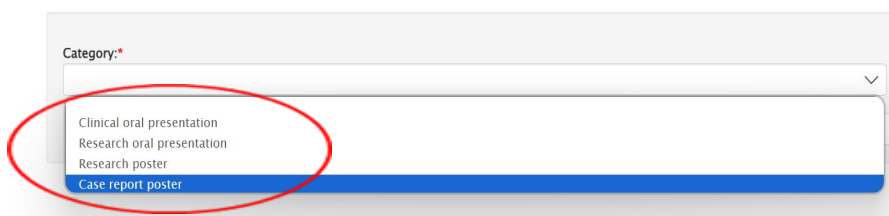
After login, it will direct you to this page:

Background:*

The Optometry profession is a governed or self-regulated health profession which serves patients with many different vision needs. Through the years of optometry training development, it is generally accepted that a university degree programme that provides a curriculum that cover traditional aspects of vision care knowledge should also be complemented with areas that we may call Optometry Specialities.

Clinical problem(s):*

A full-scope practice of optometry definition varies from country to country. In the last couple of decades, there is a proactive trend to develop optometry speciality services. Speciality services such as specialty contact lenses, sports and performance vision, vision rehabilitation, vision therapy and myopia management can be included as components of an optometry practice.
